

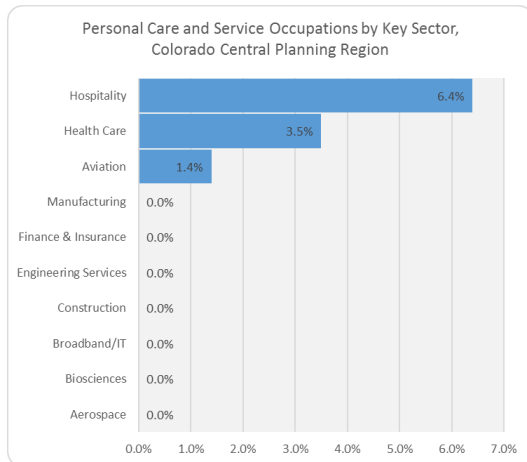
Career Pathways Infrastructure Group Personal Care and Service Occupations

All industries are made up of three groups of people:

- The **core business group**, which produce the goods or provide the services
- The **business operations group**, which is charged with advertising, marketing, budgeting and sales
- The **administration & support** group, which performs tasks that support the core and business operations groups
- A fourth group, the **infrastructure group**, performs the services that everyone else needs regardless of occupation or industry grouping

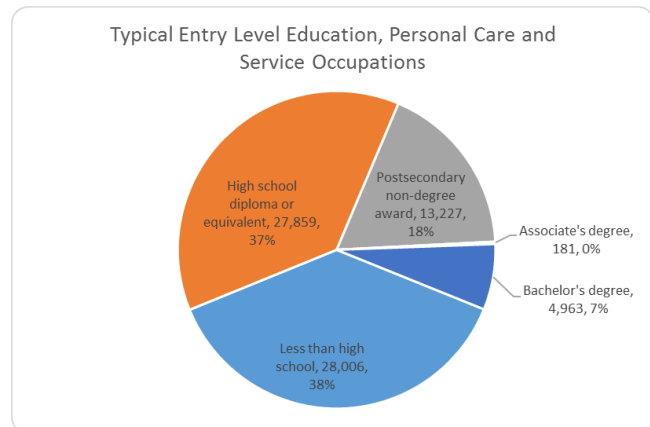

Generally, personal care and service occupations do not require high levels of education with only 25% requiring any postsecondary training at all. Most people enter these occupations with a high school diploma, and many of the jobs, such as amusement and recreation attendants offer young adults valuable opportunities to build work experience on the way through high school or college.
