

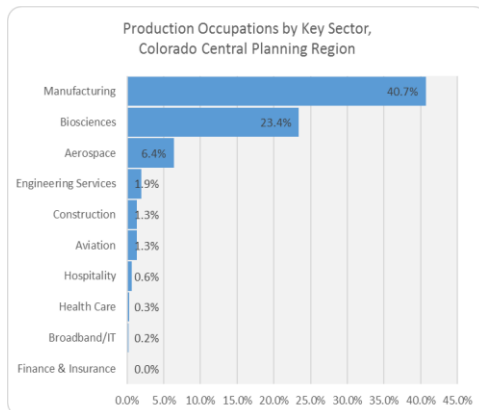
## Career Pathways Core Business Group Production Occupations

All industries are made up of three groups of people:

- The **core business group**, which produce the goods or provide the services
- The **business operations group**, which is charged with advertising, marketing, budgeting and sales
- The **administration & support** group, which performs tasks that support the core and business operations groups

About 70,000 people are employed in manufacturing occupations in the Colorado Central Planning Region, which includes the Denver-Aurora-Lakewood MSA, Boulder and Larimer counties. Of these, many are working in the manufacturing sector itself, with substantial numbers in biosciences and aerospace. Skilled production occupations, particularly in advanced manufacturing, pay well. In addition, production occupations do not require much postsecondary training at all. Many production workers learn their skills on the job, in technical schools or apprenticeships. The manufacturing floor can be an exciting place to work and will continue to offer many opportunities for people with the right skills.
