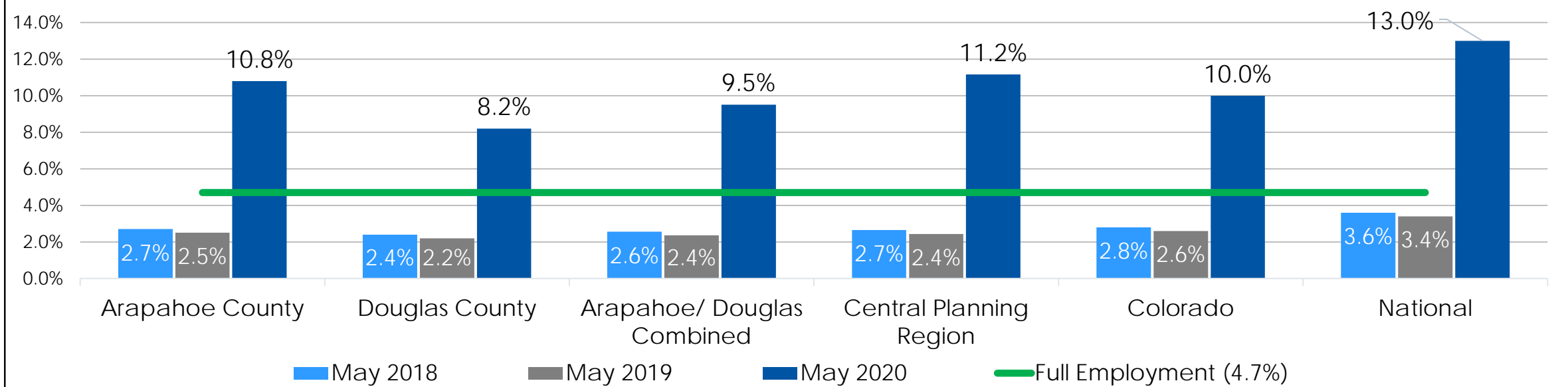

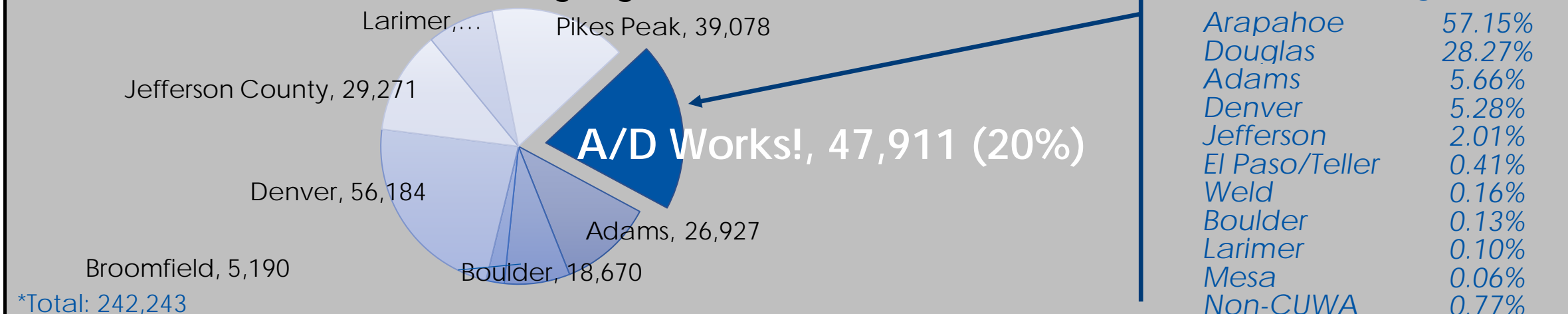

Job Seeker Breakdown by CUWA Region

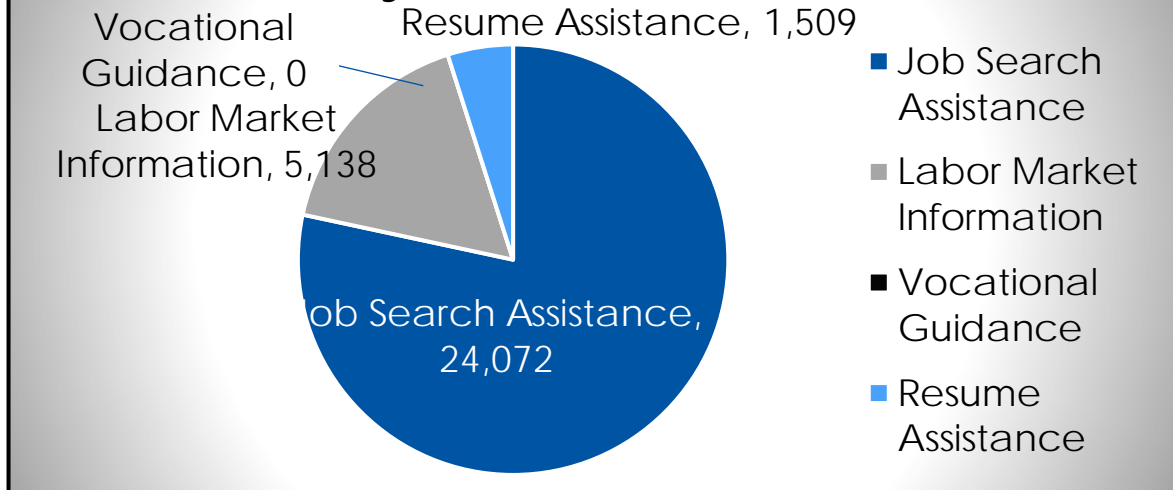
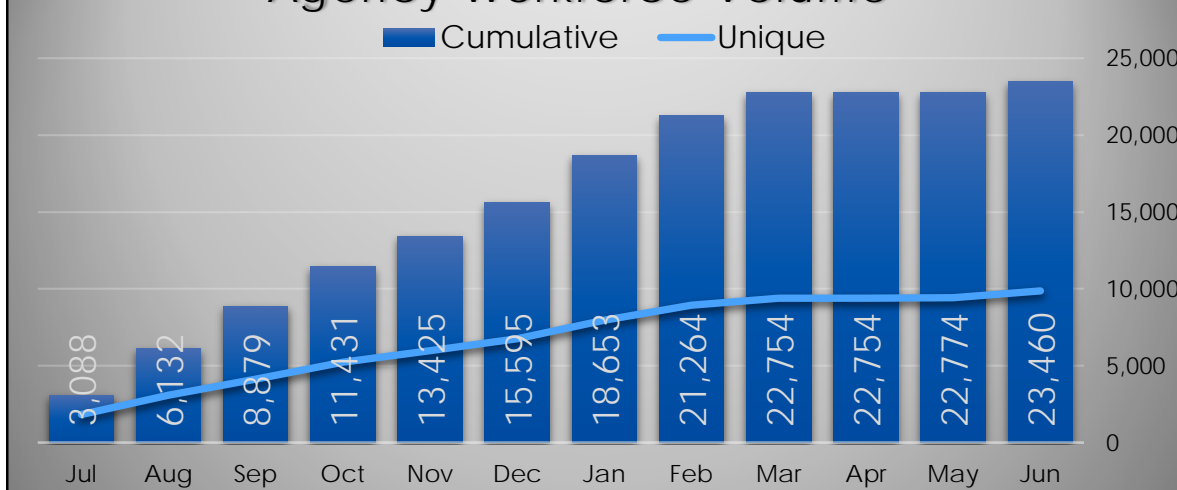


YTD Self-Reported Customer Demographics



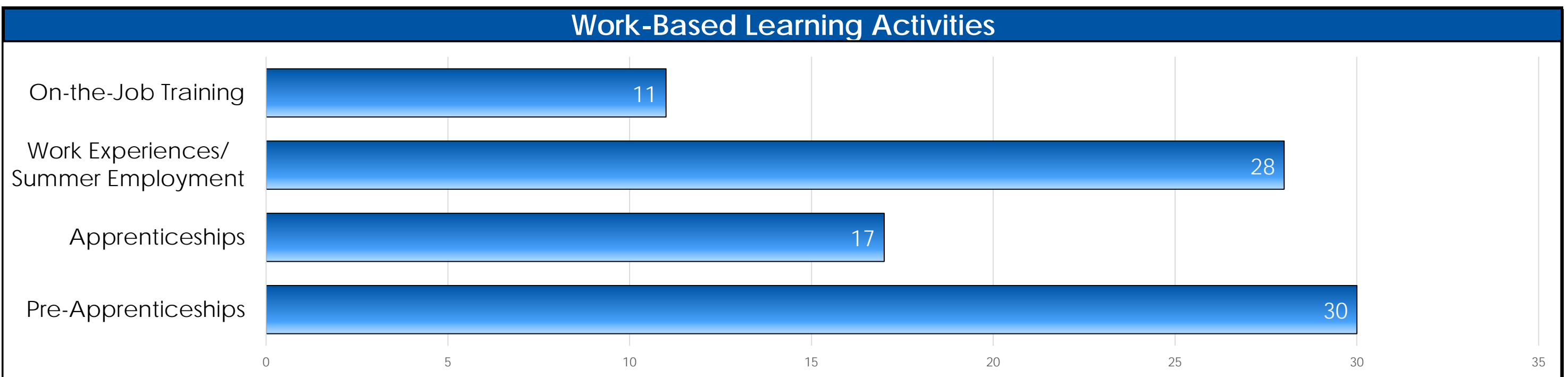
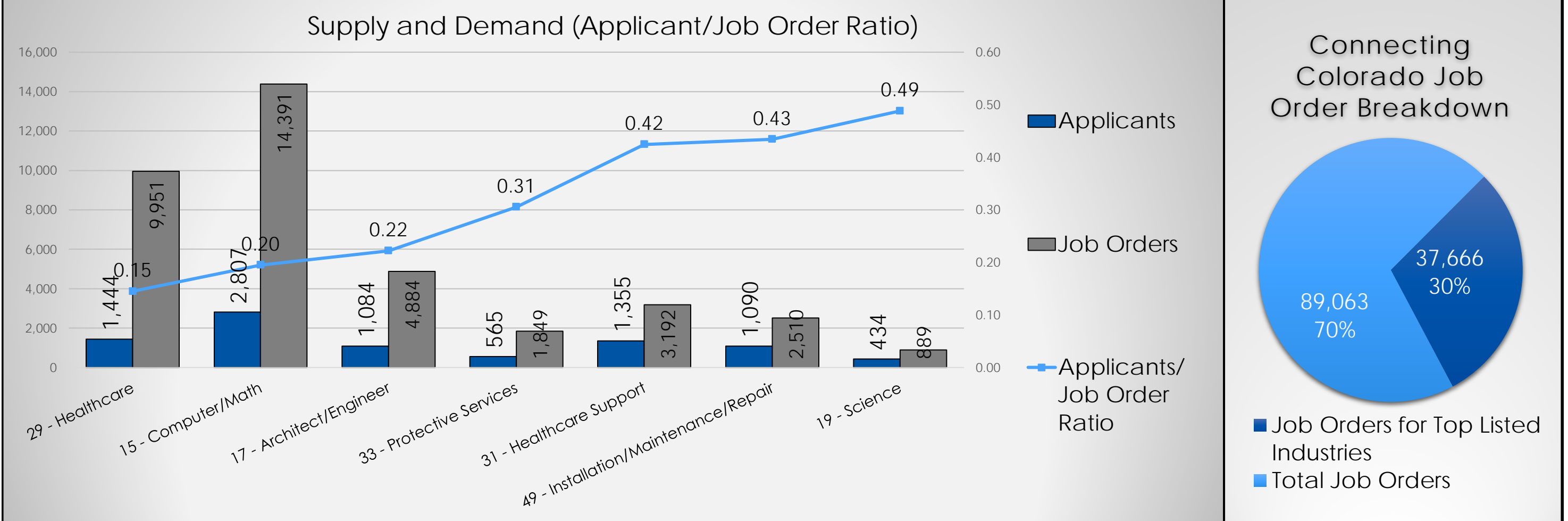
Agency Workforce Volume*
