As required by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act, Local Workforce Development Boards (LWDB) must be certified by the Governor every two years. Local Workforce Development Boards were last certified in 2018 for the two-year period ending on June 30, 2020. The Colorado Workforce Development Council (CWDC) has the responsibility of certifying or decertifying each LWDB on behalf of the Governor.

Based on the Colorado Workforce Development Council's review, and recommendations from the Colorado Department of Labor & Employment Workforce Development Programs staff, **the CWDC has certified the Arapahoe County Workforce Development Board**. This certification is effective for the period from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2022.
