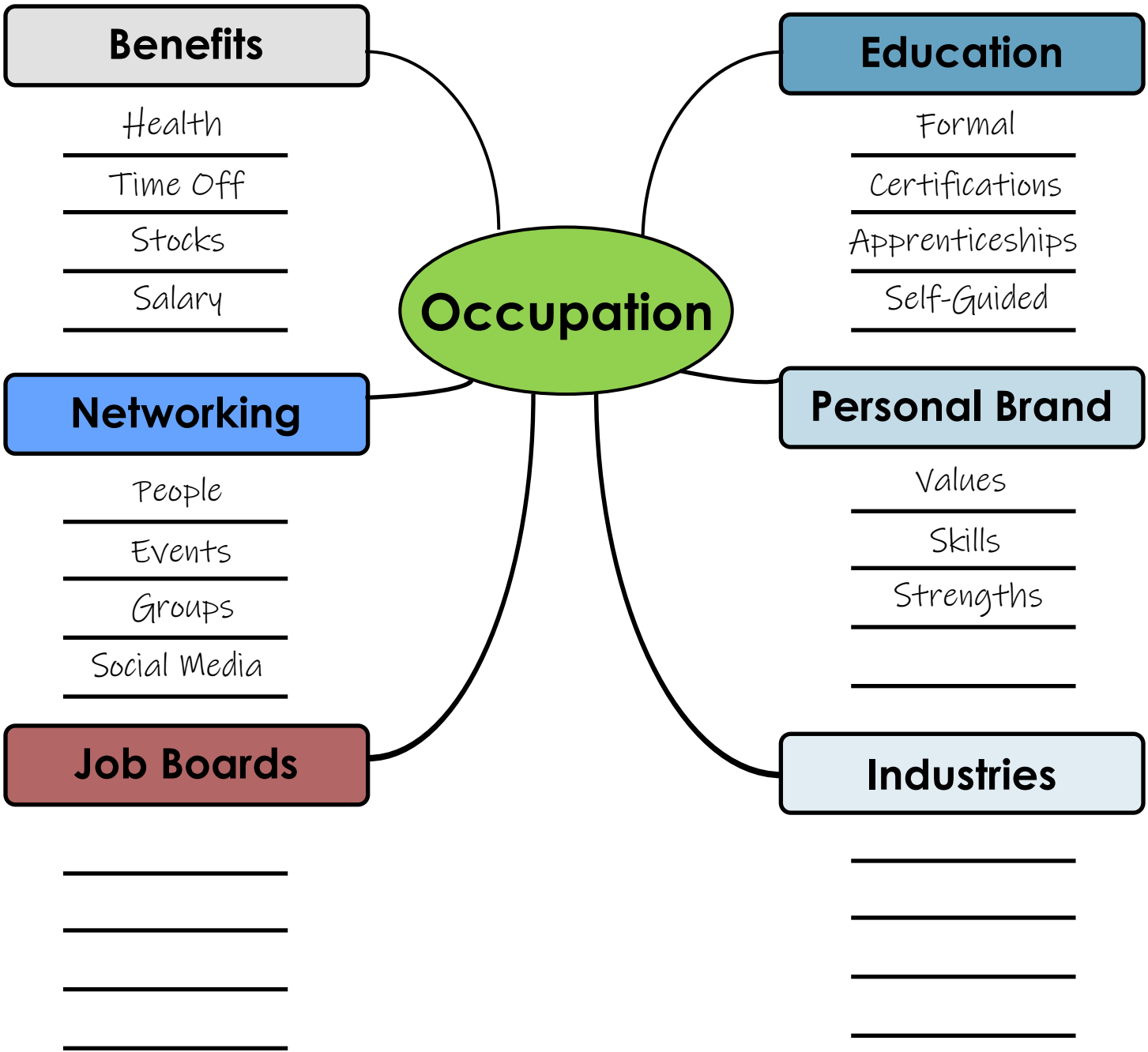

05

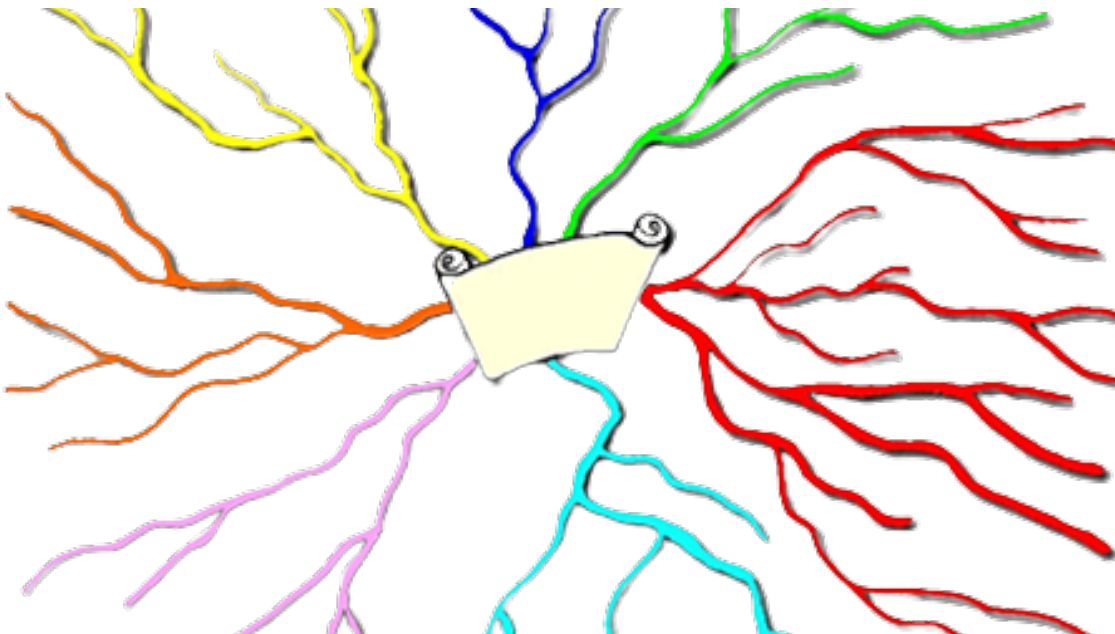
Make a list of all the positive ways the new career will impact your life.

Reinvention Committee

- **Warm & Fuzzy Supporters** - this is the friend who is guaranteed to lift your spirits.
- **Drill Sergeants** - call this person when you are stuck in a rut.
- **Industry Locals** - this is the person who is familiar with the lay of the land.



Build your mind map.

A mind map is a type of graphic organizer that uses a diagram to visually organize ideas and concepts.

The central idea is placed in the center of the diagram, and then related ideas are added to it in a radial fashion.

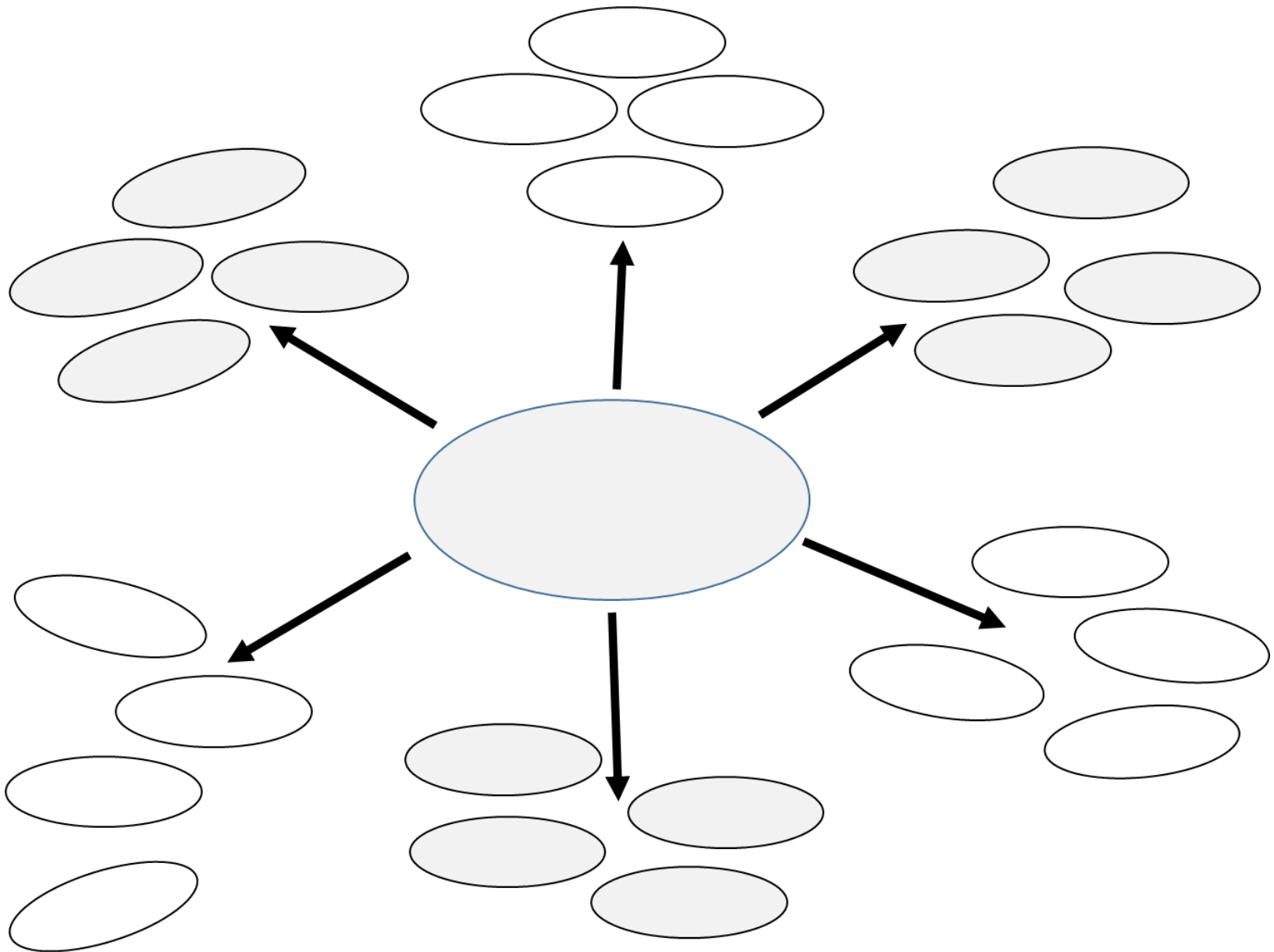
