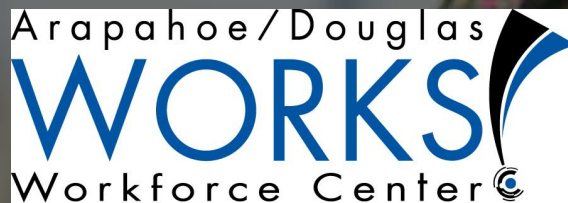

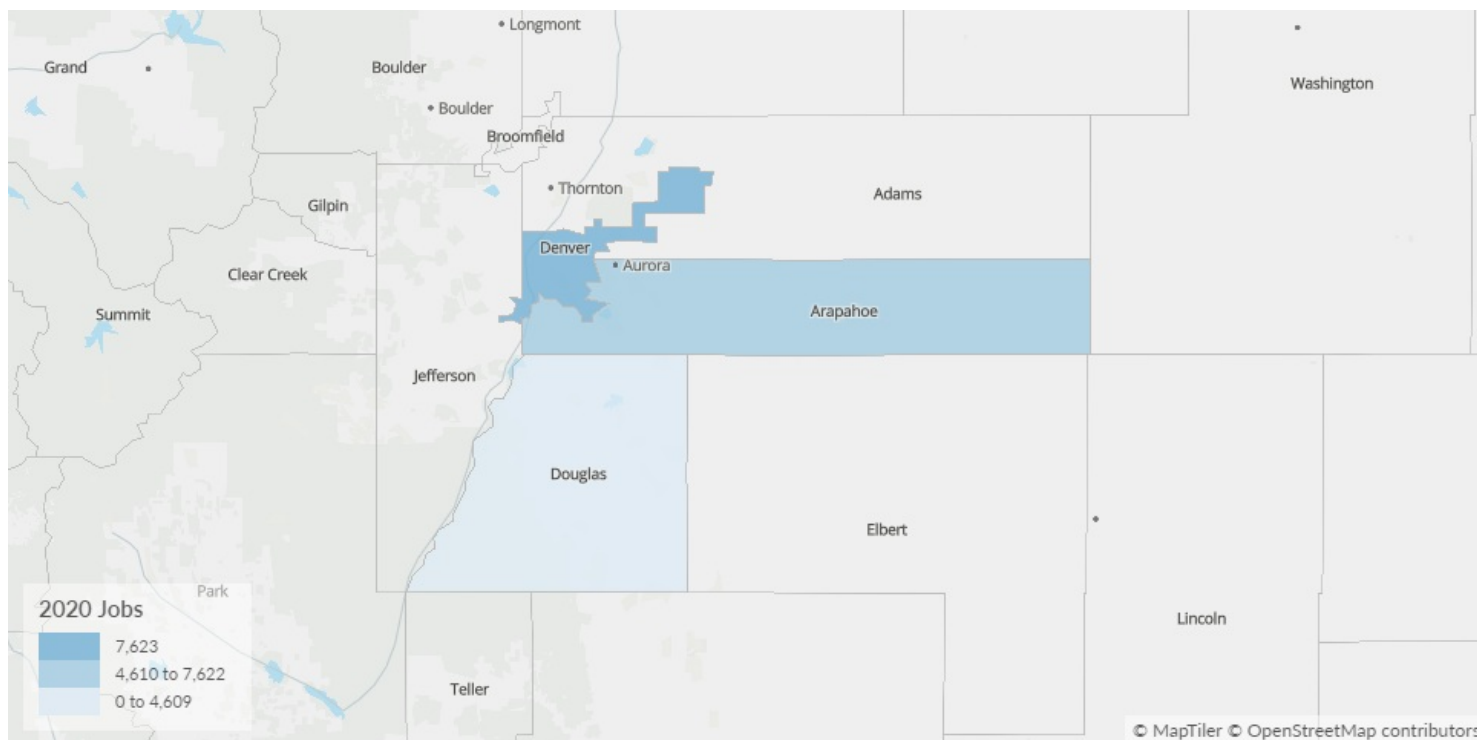

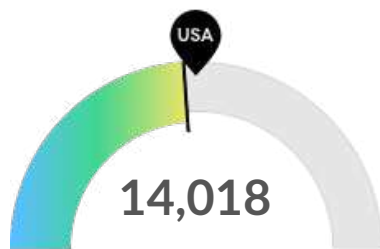

Workforce Map



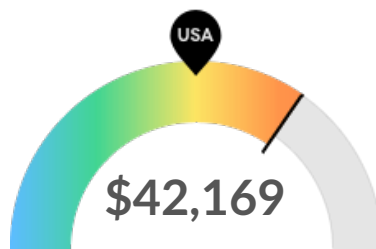

Aggressive Hiring Competition Over an Average Supply of Regional Talent



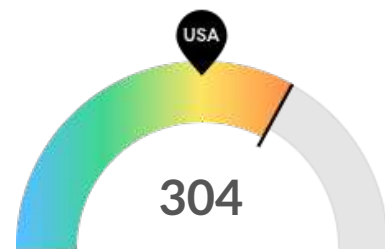
Supply (Jobs)

Demand (Job Postings)

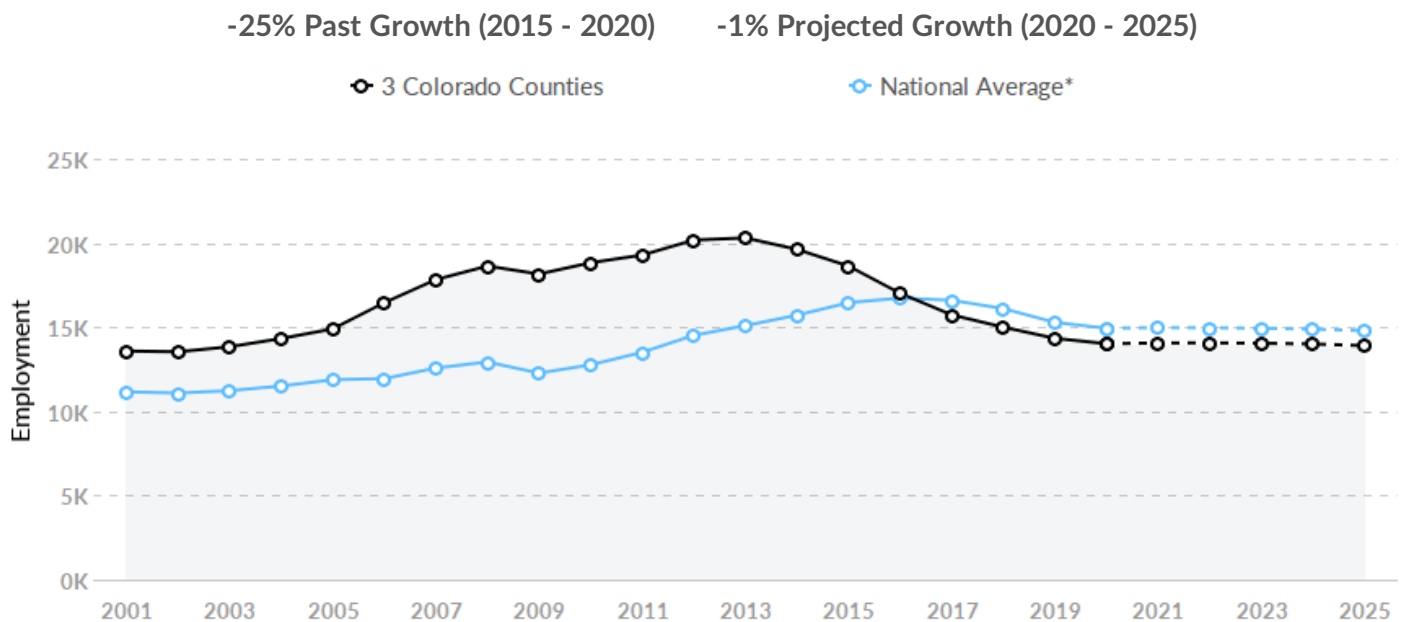
Competition from online job postings is high in your area. The national average for an area this size is 195* job postings/mo, while there are 304 here.

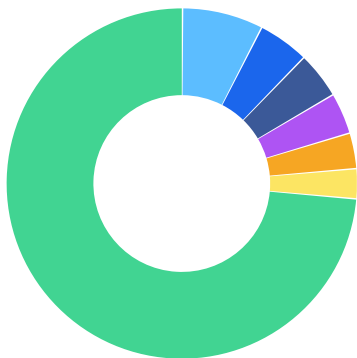
Supply Is About Equal to the National Average

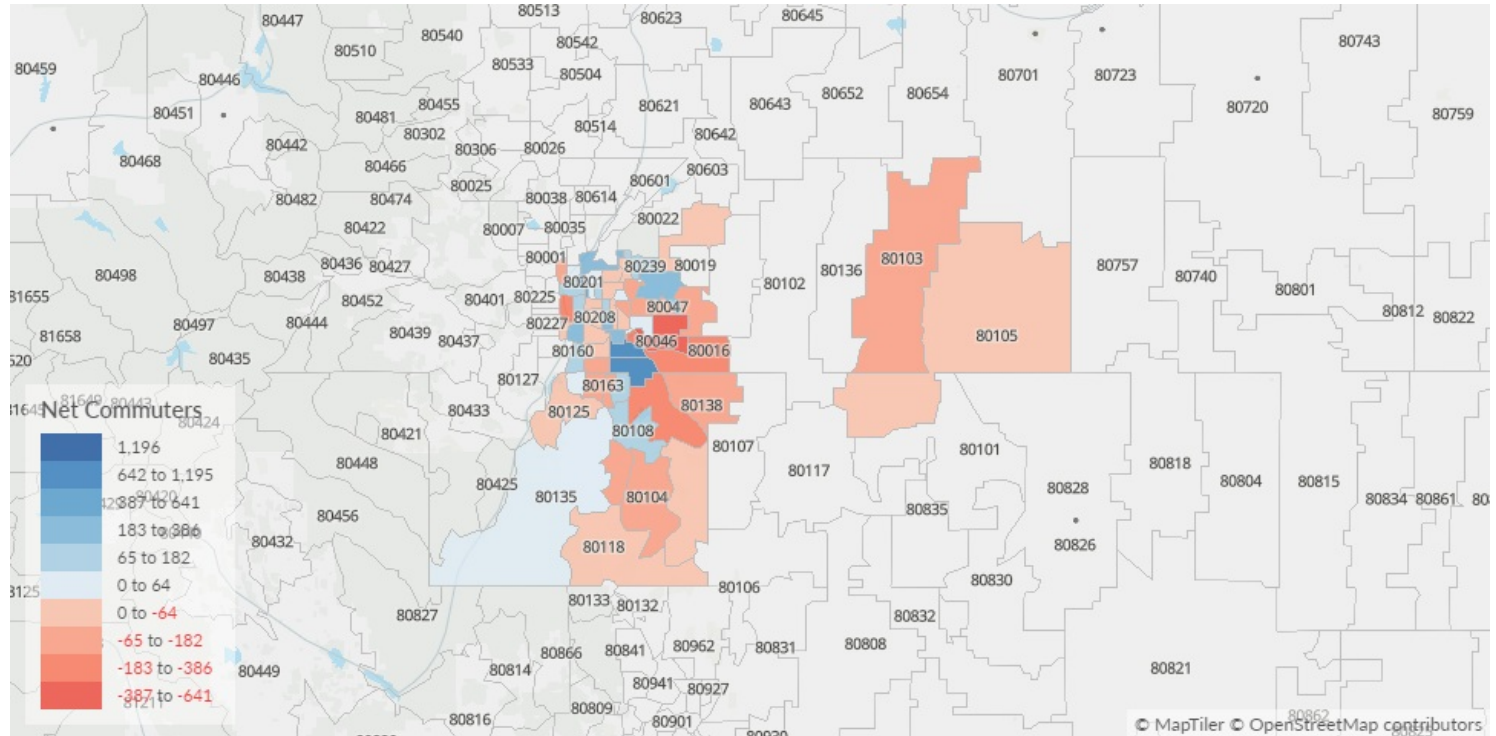

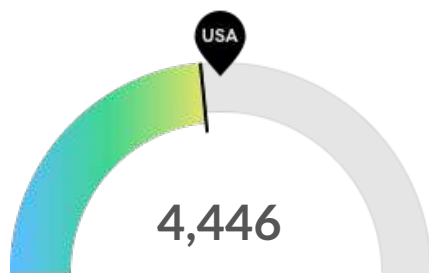

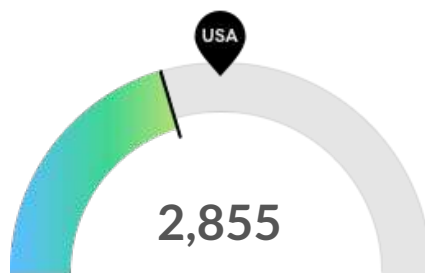

Retirement Risk Is About Average, While Overall Diversity Is Low



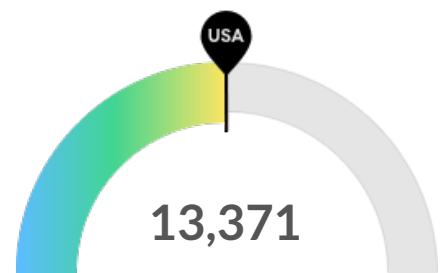
Retiring Soon

Racial diversity is low in your area. The national average for an area this size is 3,780* racially diverse employees, while there are 2,855 here.



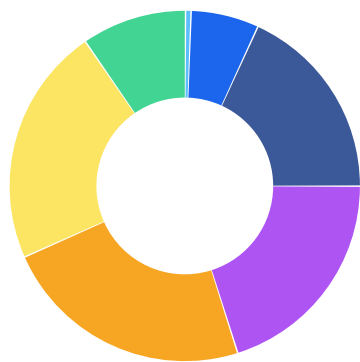
Gender Diversity

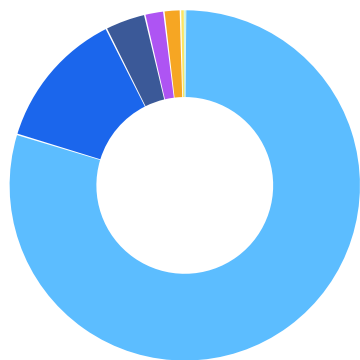

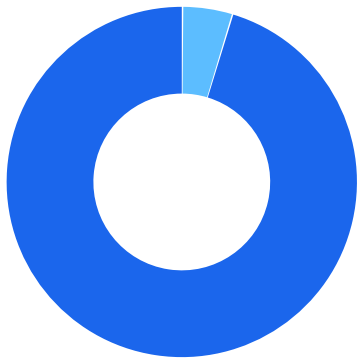

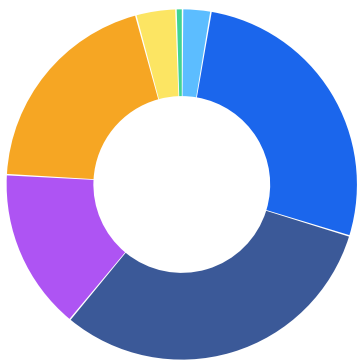

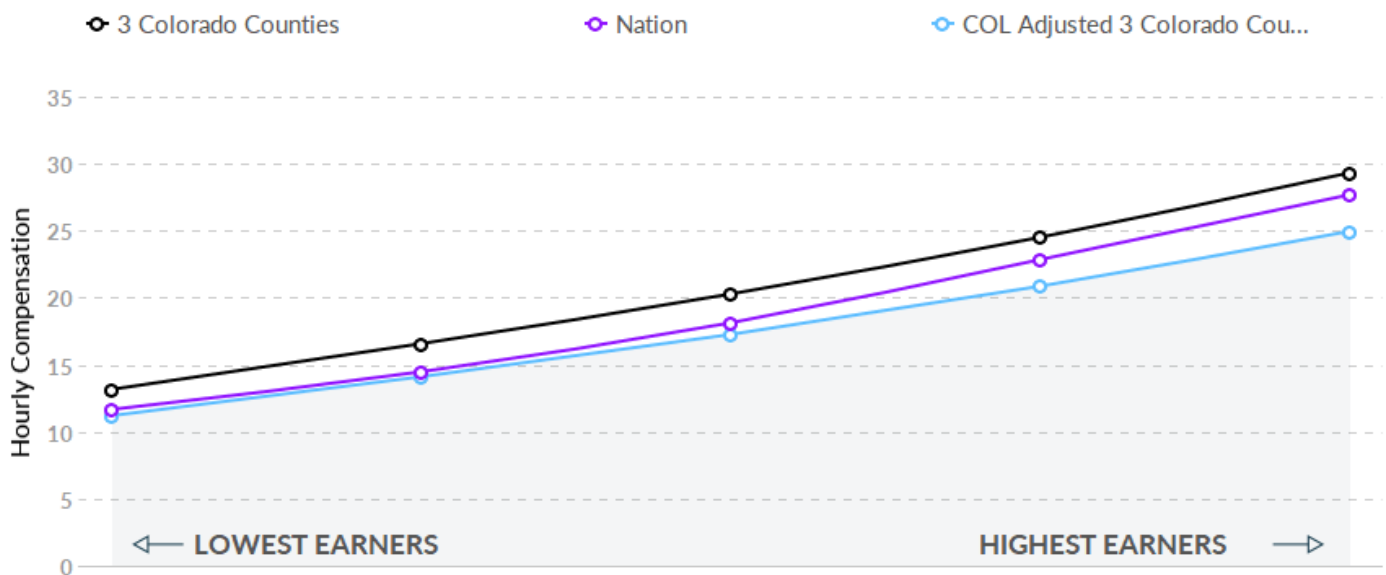

Compensation

Talent Is 12% More Expensive, While the Cost of Living May Make Attraction Difficult

In 2019, the median compensation for Administrative Assistants in your area is \$20.27/hr. Based on the national median wage of \$18.12/hr for this position, this means you will spend about 12% more to employ Administrative Assistants here. However, their actual purchasing power will be 5% less than the national median when we adjust for regional cost of living (which is 18% higher than average). This may make it harder to attract talent to the region at this price.

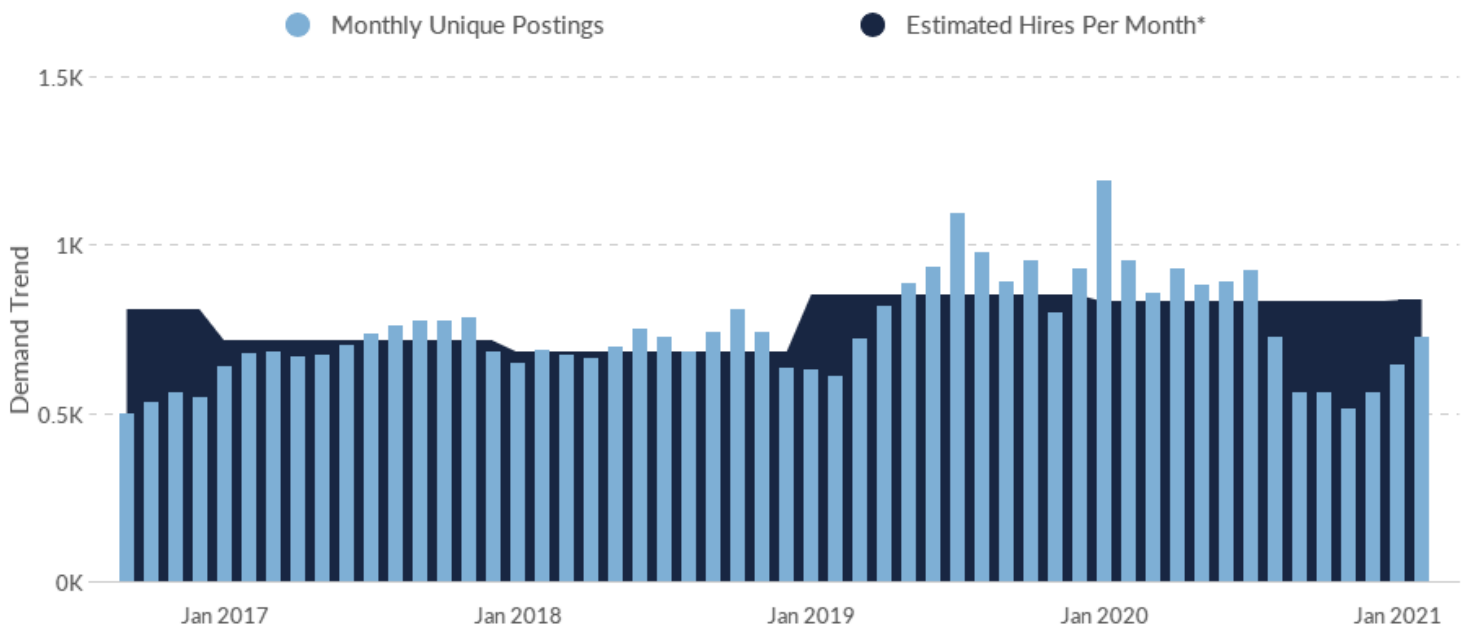

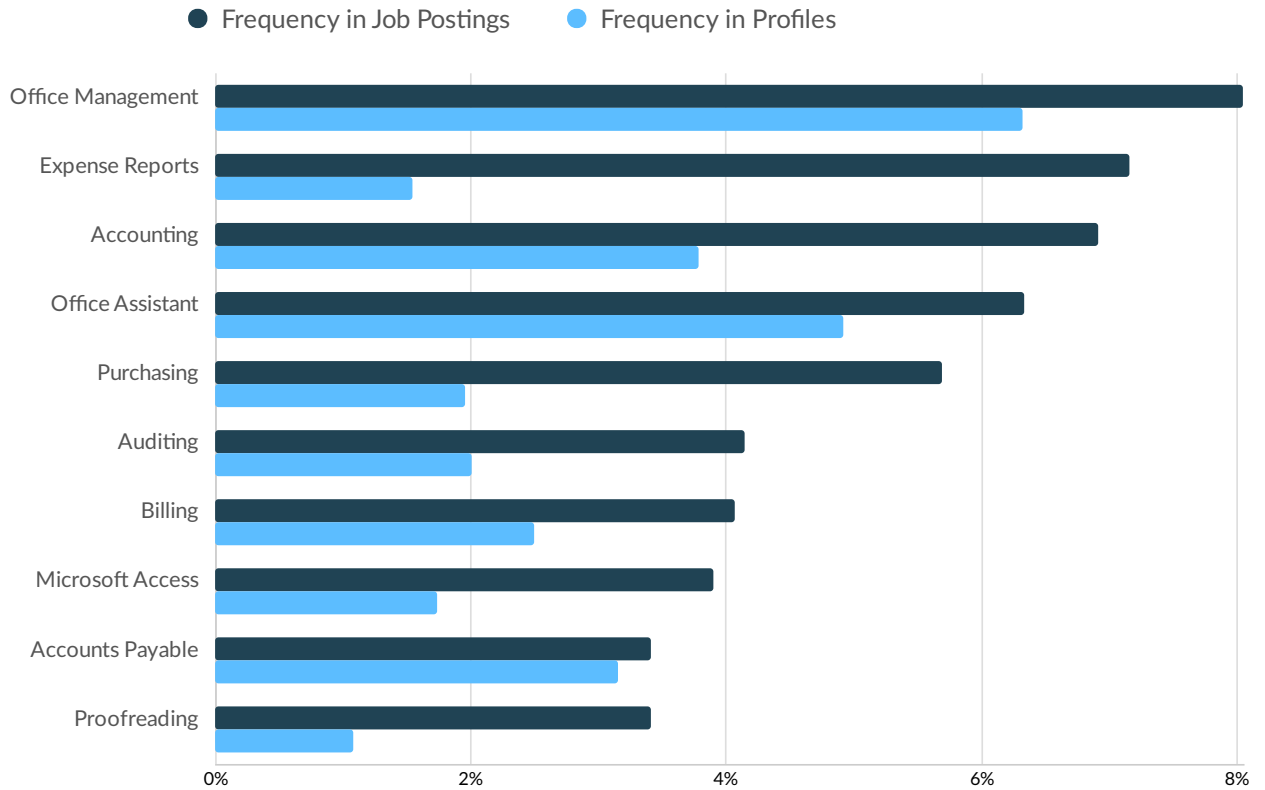

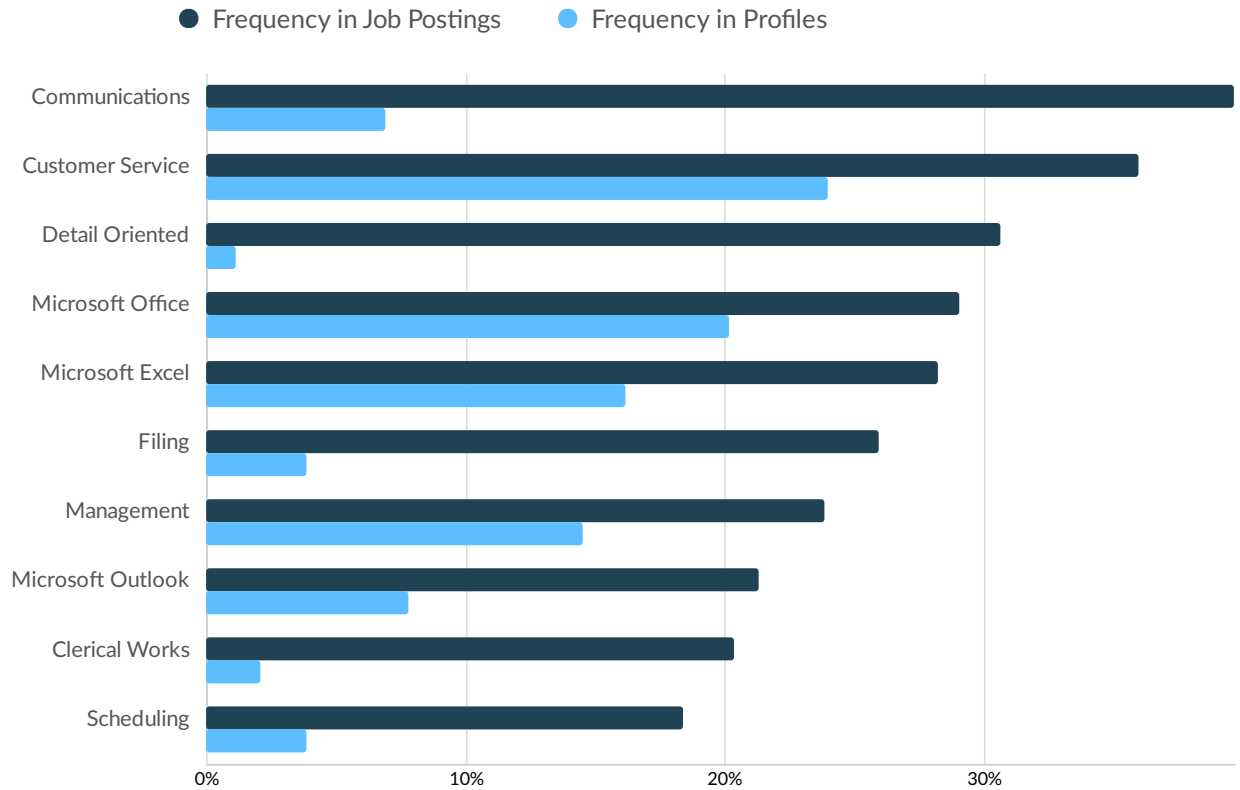
