## **Opportunity Next**

OEDIT's Latest Funding Opportunity for High-Priority Training The Office for Economic Development and International Trade (OEDIT) has launched the Opportunity Next scholarship program, made possible by SB23-205. This initiative is designed to bolster enrollment in Colorado-based postsecondary high-priority pathway training programs, including apprenticeships, paving the way for a brighter future for our learners.

Under this program, eligible participants may receive up to \$1500 in scholarship funds to cover tuition, books, equipment, and fees. Registered apprenticeship programs, eligible training providers, and technical colleges should apply by April 15th to ensure that scholarships are readily available to eligible students upon enrollment.

### The Labor Supply and Demand Report for First Quarter 2024 is Available HERE

New unemployment claims are up slightly in Colorado at 2,715 the week ending January 6, 2024. At the same time, note the rather steep upward trend with continued claims growing from just under 19,000 the week of July 8, 2023, to 32,405 the week ending January 6.

Job seeker foot traffic in Arapahoe/Douglas Works! workforce centers has grown by 77% this year, suggesting that it is taking more time for unemployed people to find work, though the labor market remains structurally scarce. Also, Coloradans now seem a bit more hesitant about quitting their jobs, with the number of 'quits' going down from 67,000 in October 2023 to 61,000 in November.

### Small Business Equity Fund Grant Program

CDPHE's Colorado Green Business Network is now accepting applications for the Small Business Equity Fund Grant Program for businesses located in Aurora and Commerce City, Colorado. The program aims to help businesses transition to energy-efficient equipment, which can save money through reduced energy use.

The Colorado Green Business Network will assess applications according to eligibility and application submission on a first-come, first-served basis while funds last. Businesses that meet the following eligibility requirements should fill out an online application. Applications are reviewed as they come in. This opportunity will conclude when funding is no longer available or by August 1, 2024, whichever comes first. Read about the grant program *HERE*.



The *Healthcare Industry* employs 261,953 people in 13,799 establishments. In 2022 the sector had \$43.4B in sales and contributed \$26.8B to the region's GRP.
