### **Hot off the Press**

#### Governor Polis Takes Executive Action to Expand Access to Work-Based Learning Opportunities and Grow the Workforce

The Polis Administration is Focused on Creating Jobs and Filling In-Demand Jobs. During his 2023 State of the State address, the Governor highlighted investments in the workforce taken by his administration including Care Forward Colorado which provides no cost-credentials for indemand jobs, as well as Career Advance Colorado and the recently announced Opportunity Now. Today, the Polis administration has met those goals for apprenticeships outlined in the 2022 Executive Order and Governor Polis is taking new executive action to rapidly expand work-based learning opportunities.



#### **Sector Spotlight**

The Aerospace and Aviation Industry employs 27,183, people in 728 establishments. An establishment is one location. A business may have several locations and each location counts as an establishment. In 2022 the sector had \$11.1B in sales and contributed \$6.4B to the region's Gross Regional Product. Colorado's Front Range is a national hub for aerospace and aviation. Because of its strength in this industry, U.S. Space Command Headquarters was moved to Colorado Springs. this makes the region a center of innovation in aerospace manufacturing, satellite technology and space exploration.

(HFWA) requires Colorado employers to provide two types of paid sick leave to their employees: accrued leave and public health emergency (PHE) leave (not currently in effect). The following points apply to both PHE and accrued leave.

 Paid sick leave must be paid for time off work, and at the same pay rate the employee earns during time worked.

 Paid sick leave can't be counted against employees as absences that may lead to firing or other negative action.
